Across the Hip



Purse-Pouch

Cast On 60 stitches.

- *Option 1* – Use a provisional cast on method, and graft the bottom together when complete. Join ends to begin knitting in the round after the first row.
- *Option 2* – Use a figure eight cast on starting with 30 figure eights on the two needles. Continue knitting in the round. Be sure to tighten this cast on row when complete, or cast on with a slightly smaller needle.

Knit 38 rows.

Rows 37-42 – Knit in moss stitch (alternating knit and purl every stitch).

Row 43 – Bind off 30 stitches, K30.

Row 44 – Sl1, P29.

Rows 45-85 – Follow rows 1-40 in the chart on page 2.

Rows 85-89 – Knit in moss stitch.

Finishing – Bind off all stitches and weave in all ends. Then follow the

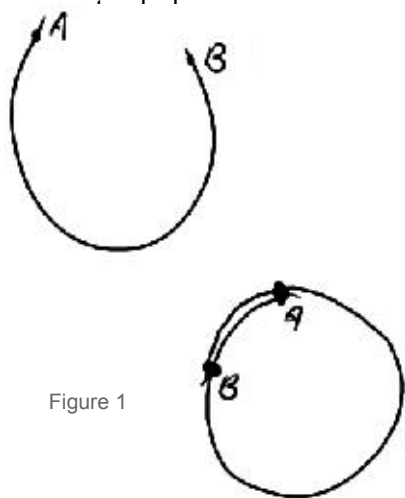

- *The strap* - Cut six strands of yarn at 55" each, and braid into one long braid. Tie each end of the braid into a simple knot. Take one end of the braid and tie it around the other end to create a loop. Make sure that your second knot allows you to slide it up and down the strand you tied it to. Tie the unknotted end to the knotted end in the same way (see Figure 1).

- *The lining (optional)* – Cut a piece of fabric 6" wide, and 18.5" long. Fold the bottom half up so it fits the size of the pouch leaving enough at the top to line the flap. Make sure there is enough for a seam at all edges where the lining will be sewn to the knitting. Sew the sides of the fabric pouch and insert into the knit pouch with the right sides facing in. Place the middle of the strap between the fabric and knit piece right where the flap folds down. Sew all fabric edges to knit edges, making sure to secure the strap to both sides as well (see Figure 2).

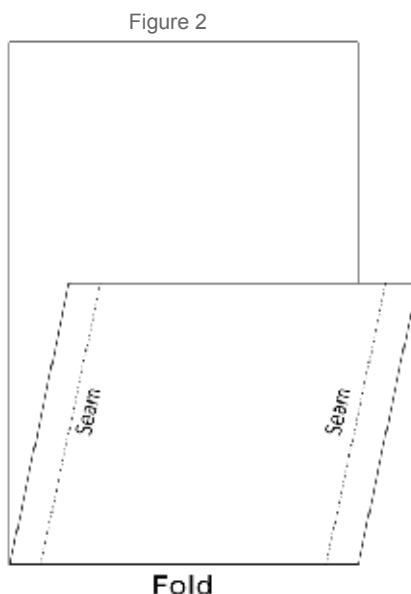

Materials

Yarn: Cash Iroha (example photo in color #100) 2 skeins

Needles: US #9 long circular needles *or* US #9 DPNs.

Lining fabric (optional)

Specifications

Gauge: 5 stitches per inch, 7 rows per inch (gauge is not crucial)

Height and Width: 6" x 6" with the front flap folded down.

Notes

- This project only takes exactly one skein to knit, plus a little bit from the second skein to make the strap.
- For yarn substitution, the yarn used in this project is 11 WPI
- For more information about how to do the Figure Eight cast-on, look for the instructions for the Figure-Eight Toe in Knitty's [Tiptop Toes](#) article. Follow the cast-on instructions, and stop following the instructions after the first whole row of stitches.

Follow the chart from top to bottom, left to right. Odd numbered rows are right side rows, and even numbered rows are wrong side rows. The colored boxes represent one repeat of a particular pattern.

K = Knit 1

P = Purl 1

S1 = Slip one p-wise making sure to carry the yarn to the back of the work for that stitch. For the first stitch in every row, slip one k-wise on odd rows, and p-wise on even rows.

LT = *Left Twist*. For the next two stitches, skip the first stitch with your right needle towards the back of the work and knit the second one through the back loop. Leave the stitch on the left needle. Then knit through both stitches through the back loop, and pull off the left needle.

RT = *Right Twist*. Knit two together, leaving both stitches on the left needle. Bring the right needle back around to the front and knit the first stitch again, slipping the needle between the two stitches. Pull stitches off the left needle.

===== = Slip 2 stitches on the right needle. Drop the next stitch off the needle to the front of the work. Slip the 2 stitches back to the left needle. Pick up the dropped stitch, and K1 P4. Drop the next stitch off the needle to the front. P2 and pick up the dropped stitch, K1.

==\===== / Drop the next stitch off the needle to the front of the work. P2 and pick up the dropped stitch, K1, P2. Slip the next two stitches to the right needle, and drop the stitch after that to the front of the work. Slip the 2 stitches back, pick up the dropped stitch, and K1.

====x==== Drop the next stitch off the needle to the front of the work. Slip the next two stitches onto the right needle. Drop the next stitch off the needle to the front of the work, and pick back up the first dropped stitch. Slip the stitches back to the left needle, and pick up the second stitch. K1, P2, K1.
